Funded by the Volkswagen Foundation and commissioned by the Club of Rome it was first presented at the St. Gallen Symposium. Its authors were Donella H. Meadows, Dennis L. Meadows, Jørgen Randers, and William W. Behrens III. The book used the World3 model to simulate the consequence of interactions between the Earth's and human systems. At the time of publication, this text had a significant impact on the desire to curb population growth. In time, the model used was found to be flawed, with the earth successfully supporting a much larger population than envisaged with lower levels of hunger than we have ever known in the modern era.






